TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN (newspapers, merchants, television)

To liken the image of a Witch to evil, ugly or green-faced is to place our people to ridicule and danger, such as naming and portraying black people as “Black Sambo” or “watermelon eating slow people” or suggesting that the Jewish race only cares for money. Such prejudice and propoganda still shows itself, especially at Halloween in Salem.

By merchants selling or decorating with this imagery, the Witch community is being down-graded and can be considered a hate crime. The large community of Witches in Salem is requesting that all merchants and neighbors cease and desist from perpetrating the stereotypical idea of Witches.
